SEASONAL BURNING OF LANDSCAPE WASTE

The burning of seasonal landscape waste such as:

- leaves
- bushes
- trees
- tree trimmings and,
- other landscaping waste

is **only allowed** for burning during the **first 2 weeks** of the month of **May** and during the **last 2 weeks** of the month of **October**. See the calendar below. Also consider visiting dcem.us with respect to fire danger when planning to burn.

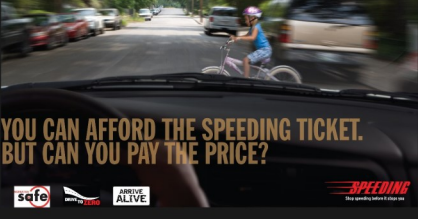

SPRINKLER SYSTEM USAGE

Just a reminder per City Code Chapter 90.20(11) Even/Odd Operation. Properties with even-numbered addresses may irrigate only on even-numbered days. Properties with odd-numbered addresses may irrigate only on odd-numbered days. In efforts to put less strain on the Water Plant during peak water demand when our population increases during Memorial Day, 4th of July, and Labor Day we ask that you refrain from using your sprinkler system.

PARKING REGULATIONS

In the discretion of a law enforcement officer, if conditions warrant, the officer may issue a "Notice of Violation" in regard to violations of any provisions of Chapter 69 of the Wahpeton City Code, "Parking Regulations", except Section 69.08 (Persons with Disabilities Parking). A "Notice of Violation in this section is in the amount of \$200.00.
